



## Internship at the Institute of the Regions of Europe (IRE) **Experience Europe!** Science and Practice

Since June 2005, the Institute of the Regions of Europe (IRE) has created the opportunity for young students from all over Europe (third-member states only under the Erasmus Mobility Program) to spend a month at the interface between science and practice of European politics. You will be integrated into projects of the institute, given specific tasks as well as plans and will write a scientific paper with a European political or regional policy focus, which will be published within the framework of the IRE publication series. In this way you will gain experience in European regional policy, analyze political events and support us in the organization of international conferences. You are insured and receive for your activity a pocket money of 200, - Euro. When traveling to conference events, the IRE pays for travel and accommodation. At the end of your activity, you present your scientific work and receive a certificate.



### Requirements:

- Must be an undergraduate or have a recently completed a graduate degree (Bachelor, Master, PhD) in the field of politics, law, history, geography, economics or European studies;
- Basic knowledge of the European Union and its institutions.

### Duties:

- Co-organization of international conferences at home and abroad;
- Make new contacts with regions and cities across Europe;
- Scientific activities, such as library construction and support research and topics;
- Writing a scientific paper on a topic of free choice in consultation with the chairman of the institute. This work is published as part of the Institute's series of publications

**The IRE offers internships for one month each at its headquarters in Salzburg (Nonntaler Hauptstrasse 58) in the period from January to December 2019.** Since the founding of the IRE in Salzburg, a total of 300 interns from over 20 countries have worked at the Institute.
